4. Any one who has applied for these posts based on previous advertisement, if any, is ineligible and have to apply afresh on a new application form, based on the present advertisement.

5. Interested candidates should send their applications as per format attached to "**The Commandant, Headquarters, Artillery Centre, Nasik Road Camp PIN – 422102**" through ordinary post. Candidates must clearly subscribe the words "**Application for the post of _____ in Category _____ (Gen, SC, ST, OBC, EWS, ESM, PHP, and MSP)**" on the top of the envelope while sending the application form.

6. Photocopy of the following documents / certificate to be attached alongwith application **duly self-attested:-**

- (a) Mark sheet of the essential educational qualification.
- (b) Matriculation certificate / Municipality Birth Certificate for birth proof/ School Leaving Certificate.
- (c) One self addressed envelope duly affixed with Rs 5/- postal stamp.
- (d) One latest passport size photograph duly attested by self on back side of photograph.
- (e) Discharge Book in case of Ex-serviceman persons duly attested by Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer, PPO and AEC I / II or matriculation certificate as applicable.
- (f) Employment registration card, if any.
- (g) Experience certificate, if any.
- (h) Photocopy of Caste Certificate (SC/ST & OBC) duly attested by self for reserved posts.
- (j) If candidate applying for PHP, copy of disability/medical certificate issued by civil surgeon of Govt Hospital/CMO certifying the disability.

7. The following applications will be summarily rejected:-

- (a) Application without signature of the candidate.
- (b) Application other than prescribed Performa as published in advertisement.
- (c) Application received through Fax / AWAN.
- (d) Application received after due date for any reason.
- (e) Incomplete / Illegible application.
- (f) Latest photograph not pasted on application form and not attested by self and if no additional photograph is enclosed.
- (g) Mark sheet of essential qualifications not attested.
- (h) Only a single application will be entertained for one category/post. Candidates who forward more than one application form for the same category/post, their candidature will be rejected outright without any notice to such candidates.

8. It is made clear that merely fulfilling the basic essential qualification does not, automatically entitle a person to be called for written test. The selection will be made strictly on merit basis. The decision of appointing authority regarding selection / rejection will be final. No weightage can be given for additional qualification other than the prescribed in the Recruitment Rules.

9. Applications will be short listed for further selection process on the basis of percentage of marks obtained in the essential qualification examination.

10. Question Paper will be Objective Type with Negative Marking of **0.25** Marks for each wrong answer. English language test for LDC only will include questions on composition and comprehension.

11. Date of Written Test / Skill Test will be intimated to eligible candidates separately. Examination will be conducted at Nasik (Maharashtra) only.

12. No enquiry or correspondence for any information will be entertained.

13. Candidates living with more than one spouse or married to another spouse while the first spouse is alive, shall not be eligible to apply.

14. SC/ST/OBC candidate applying for **General Category** post is not entitled to any relaxation in the age limit.

15. Appointing authority reserves the right to reject the candidature of a candidate for written test /skill test. The candidates to be called for the written test and skill test shall be short listed, by applying all or any of the slated norms.

16. Canvassing in any form and / or bringing in any influence, political or otherwise shall be treated as a disqualification for the test / post. Interim queries shall not be entertained.

17. Candidates who fulfill the eligibility criteria shall be subjected to selection process as per existing orders and the selected candidates shall be appointed only after verification of Character and antecedent from police authority and if found fit after medical examination.

18. The candidates selected shall be governed by the provision of the **New Pension Scheme (NPS) - 2004**.

19. Selected candidates shall be initially posted to any of the three Defence Establishment at Nashik as per vacancy with subsequent all India Service transfer liability.

20. No TA / DA is admissible to the candidates for appearing for written test/skill test.

21. The decision of the Appointing Authority regarding selection / rejection shall be final.

22. Appointing authority has right to cancel / postpone / suspend / terminate / modify this Notification of recruitment process without any prior notice / assigning any reasons at any stage and no enquiry or correspondence will be entertained for any information.

23. The recruitment board's decision will be final in all matters and the board will not undertake any responsibility for sending a reply to the candidates, if not selected.

24. The Commandant shall not be responsible for any postal delay or failure. The No of posts/vacancies is subject to increase/decrease based on the actual requirement at the time of recruitment.

25. The candidates appointed as "Multi Tasking Staff" will perform the duties, as per 'Charter of Duties of Multi Tasking Staff'.
